## Greg Fisher

Greg Fisher portrays George Washington in the autumn of 1774 as he looks back on his years of service as a vestryman and church warden. He will discuss the role of a vestry-man in Truro Parish, the planning and building of Pohick Church, and his hopes for the future as he leaves for Philadelphia as a delegate to the first Continental Congress.



Mr. Fisher has been portraying George Washington for more than 14 years. He has made many appearances as Washington (Old Senate Chamber, Washington's Headquarters Museum, Kenmore Mansion and Ferry Farm, Mary Washington House, Lyceum Museum, and Gadsby's Tavern).

He served as a non-commissioned officer in the U.S. Army before retiring after 21 years of active duty service. He served in three combat zones and worked at the Pentagon and the White House.
