A Federal Records Workshop

The Society for History in the Federal Government announces its inaugural Federal Records Workshop to be held Friday, February 1, 2013, at the Boeing Learning Center at the National Archives and Records Administration in Washington, D.C. The workshop is designed for graduate students and advanced undergraduate students seeking an introduction to how to use the rich and voluminous federal records at National Archives.

Pairs of historians and archivists will team-teach sessions on using executive civilian, military, legislative, and judicial records. Topics covered will include an overview of NARA's holdings in each grouping; how to prepare for research at the archives; and how to develop a research strategy. Veteran historians and archivists also will provide anecdotes and insights based on their own research work.

The cost is \$25 per individual; and includes a year-long membership to the SHFG (normally \$20 at the student rate).

Participants also are welcome to attend a post-workshop reception at DC Hop House (509 7th Street, NW) to meet and network with SHFG members from a variety of federal history offices.
