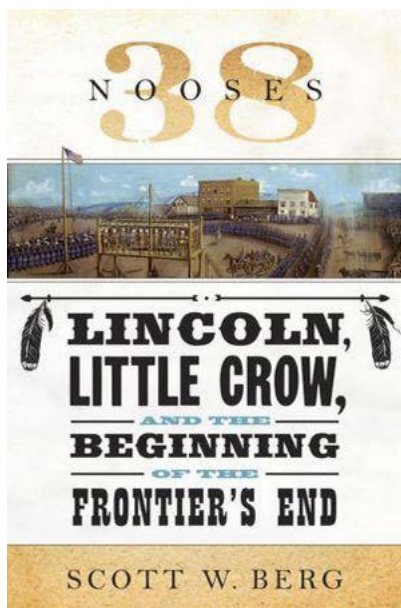


Join us on November 6th for the first

Alumni-Faculty Well Library Induction Ceremony

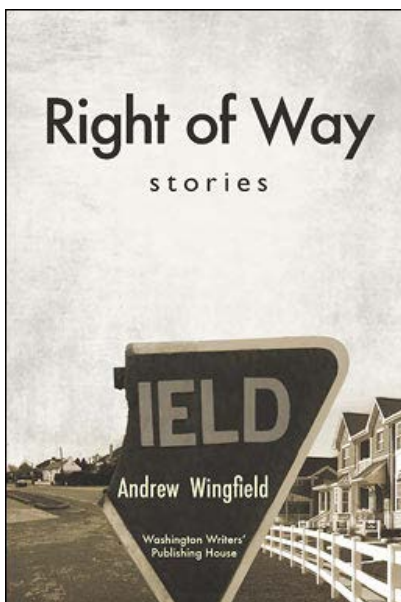


38 Nooses by Scott Berg

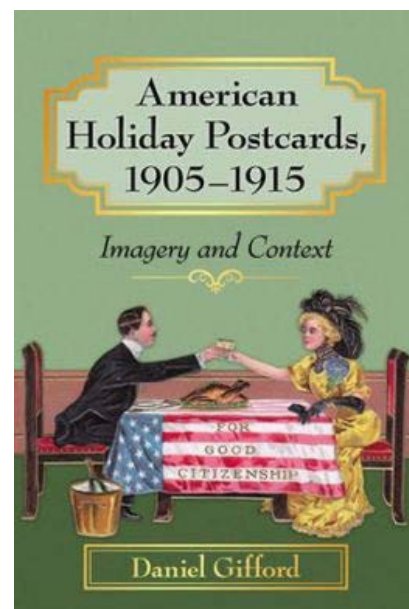
On Wednesday, November 6th, at 6 p.m. come out to the first Alumni-Faculty Well Library induction ceremony, recognizing the work of alumni who have stayed at Mason and become faculty members. Inductees include three MFAers--Scott Berg (fiction, '97), Mel Nichols (poetry, '99) and Andrew Wingfield (fiction, '99)--as well as Daniel Gifford from History, who holds both a master's and ph.d. from Mason.
