When: Summer 2014 term (application deadline January 27, 2014)

Where: Sterling, VA

Duties: Duties will vary based on workload, but could include maintaining forensic equipment, drive sterilization, research, hardware and software testing, troubleshooting, shipping and repairs. Coding/Scripting might also be possible for the right person.

Who: Degree-seeking junior to graduate students who are registered for an internship at their university for credit.
Must be in good standing at the university.
Must be able to pass an extensive background investigation.
Should be tech savvy and have an interest in computer forensics.

More: This is a non-paid internship for degree-seeking students who need internship credit for their college program.
Hours are flexible, but must be conducted during weekday business hours.
