

Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center Pacific hereby publicizes its intention to solicit, negotiate, and award a Technical Direction Letter on a competitive basis to provide a Micro-Electro-Mechanical Systems (MEMS) fabrication facility and training on the specific equipment.

Space and Naval Warfare Center Pacific (SSC-PAC) seeks MEMS fabrication facilities where SSC-PAC employees can engage in MEMS CAD design, and fabricate MEMS devices during an eight week period for up to nine individuals (a minimum of four hours per week per SSC-PAC participant). University support in providing access to such facilities, and training specific to the equipment available is required. The MEMS facility should be within one hour's travel by car from SSC-PAC in San Diego, CA.

Be advised that the aforementioned information is anticipatory in nature and is not binding. This notice is not a request for competitive quotes or proposals; however, any University believing that they can fulfill the requirement of providing these services may be considered by the agency. Interested parties may identify their interest and capabilities in response to this synopsis, and must clearly show the University's ability to be responsive without compromising the quality, accuracy, and reliability of services provided.
