The work will involve prediction modeling using specialized clinical databases including the National Surgical Quality Improvement Program (NSQIP), Vascular Quality Initiative (VQI), National Trauma Database (NTDB) and VA Corporate Data Warehouse (CDW) databases. The statistician must be skilled in using SAS and other programming languages for manipulation of large databases. Experience using logistic regression and general linear models is required, and familiarity with R would be beneficial.
