- Deliver lectures and other teaching activities on statistical topics for medical researchers
- Participate in CTU group meetings and activities such as reviewing clinical trial concepts and protocols
- Participate in internal research and development activities

Position Qualifications:

- Master's degree in biostatistics or statistics
- Excellent SAS programming skills, with strong ability to manage and manipulate complex, large-scale data sets; Experience using R is a plus
- Experience in longitudinal data analysis and multi-level modeling is required
- Knowledge of clinical and translational research, clinical trials or related research
- Excellent written and interpersonal communication skills
- 2 or more years of professional work experience in the field of public health or a related field is highly desirable
