Course Description

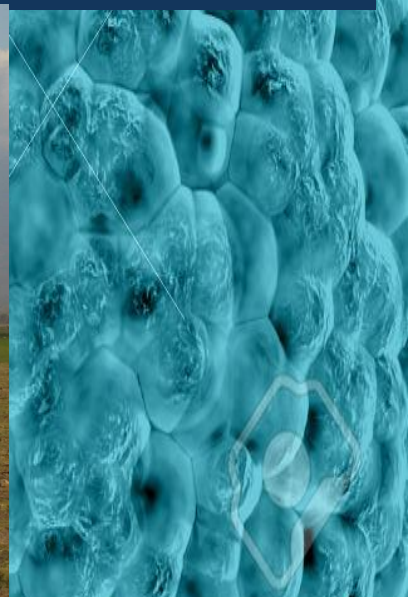
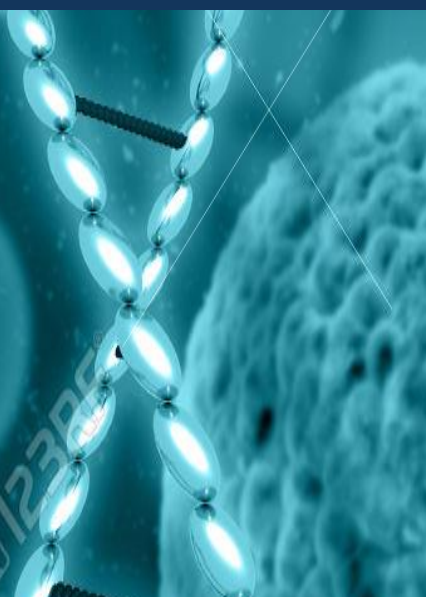
- Explores emerging infectious diseases with an emphasis on prevention and control interventions at the local through global levels.
