

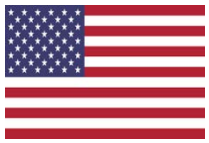

The road to diplomatic negotiations with North Korea has been a long, winding, and dangerous one. Join CSPA for this unique learning experience where you will represent one of six countries to negotiate a peaceful settlement to North Korea's nuclear program. Working with your counterparts from the other five countries, you will address four key challenges. The parties must come to an agreement on all four issues together, or no agreement will be declared. You will receive more information closer to the event date.

Space is extremely LIMITED and will be capped at 60 participants, so register as soon as possible to ensure a seat at the negotiation table. The final day to register for the event is October 25th. A light breakfast will be served before the simulation, with a lunch served at the conclusion of the event.
