For Applied Research in Public-Sector Airport-Related Aviation Issues

Awards:

- Up to 12 one-year awards of \$12,000 each.

Application Requirements:

- Cover page form from Sponsored Program Office
- Electronic plus 1 hard copy submission
- Two letters of recommendation collected electronically
- Faculty advisor commitment form collected electronically
- Official transcripts
- Research proposal
- Writing sample

Eligibility:

- Open to students who are U.S. or Canadian citizens, permanent residents, or current student visa holders.
- Must be enrolled full-time in a graduate degree program at an accredited U.S. or Canadian institution of higher learning during the 2022-2023 academic year.

Sponsor:

- Sponsored by Federal Aviation Administration, administered by the Transportation Research Board's Airport Cooperative Research Program, and managed by Virginia Space Grant Consortium.

Recognition:

- Students are mentored by a national panel of expert advisors.
- Winners present final research papers at Transportation Research Board Annual Meeting.
- Papers are considered for publication as part of the Compendium of Papers for the meeting and considered for publication in the Transportation Research Record.
