

Call for Posters – 2023 Innovation Week

All George Mason University community members (especially students) are welcome to submit posters (and associated abstracts) for the College of Engineering and Computing's 2023 Innovation Week Activities under the theme: **Creating the Future; Innovating in Solidarity**.

The poster session offers the opportunity for presenters to share their work through a quick introduction to the entire conference audience, followed by one-on-one discussions next to the poster. There will be three categories: Undergraduate Students; Graduate Students; and Faculty

Posters will be judged by GMU senior administration and student body officers, where first, second, and third prize student posters will be chosen!

Submission Instructions

Authors are not expected to present their poster during 2023 I-Week sessions in the Nguyen Engineering Building Atrium - but they are welcome to. If present, please be prepared to showcase and to give a one minute introductory lightning talk.

The submission should cover the following information:

1. **Poster Title**
2. **Names**
3. **Academic Level (undergrad/grad/faculty)**
4. **Major**
5. **Student author (Y/N)**
6. **A brief abstract** (less than or equal to 300 words)

We strongly recommend all submissions primarily follow the Word template [here](#).

All posters must use the A1 format (594 x 841 mm/23.4 x 33.1 in).

All submissions will be reviewed by the Innovation Week Poster Committee and decisions will be made available via email.

Authors are expected to respond to review comments and, if necessary, resubmit their updated poster and abstract.

All accepted posters can also prepare a 1 min lightning talk (one slide) of their work, in case they opt to present during the 2023 I-Week Activities.

We are arranging to have accepted posters printed and we will also have boards on which the accepted posters will hang.

Please note the following

1. Digital file **MUST** be received by 13th February 2023 to ensure printing/setup in Atrium
2. Files must be in PDF format - A1 poster size (594 x 841 mm/23.4 x 33.1 in)
3. Minimum 150dpi images & embed fonts (Press Quality or High Quality when converting to PDF)
